Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby finds, as required by California Code of Health and Safety Code Section 17958.5, that the following amendments to the Building Code are necessary for the specific climatic, topological, and geological reasons listed below:

Additional fire, structural and other protection is required due to high building density and crowded occupancy: Section 504.

Section 2. The San Francisco Housing Code is hereby amended by amending Section 504, to read as follows:

Sec. 504. . LIGHT AND VENTILATION.

(c) Mechanical Ventilation. An approved system of mechanical ventilation or air conditioning may be used in lieu of openable <u>exterior</u> windows <u>in other than habitable rooms</u>. Such system shall provide not less than two air changes per hour, except that in bathrooms, <u>containing a bathtub, shower or combination thereof, toilet compartments</u>, laundry rooms and similar rooms such system shall provide five air changes per hour. A minimum of 15 cubic feet per occupant of the air supply shall be taken from the outside per Section 1203.3 of the Building

Code. The point of discharge of exhaust air shall be at least three feet from any opening into the building.

Bathrooms that contain only a water closet, lavatory or combination thereof and similar rooms may be ventilated with an approved mechanical recirculating fan or similar device designed to remove odors from the air.
