12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
14 Section 20.30, to read as follows:

15 **SEC. 20.30. FINGERPRINT IMAGING OF HUMAN SERVICES CLIENTS.**

16 The Department of Human Services shall not require fingerprint biometric imaging of clients
17 in order to access services, unless required by State, Federal, or grant programs, or those required
18 expressly authorized by voter initiative, or the County Adult Assistance Programs including
19 Personal Assistance Employment Services (PAES), Supplemental Security Income Pending
20 (SSIP), Cash Assistance Linked to MediCal (CALM), and General Assistance (GA).




