Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding Section 32.6.32, to read as follows:

Sec. 32.6.32. No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, on the south side of Stevenson Street, from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to 294 feet easterly, except for law enforcement vehicles of any jurisdiction. Violation of this Section is an obstruction to the free use of property and a nuisance within the meaning of Division 4, Part III of the Civil Code of California relating to nuisance and the abatement thereof. Any vehicle found in violation of this Section shall be subject to removal under the provisions of Section 22651(n) of the Vehicle Code of the State of California.
