[Eligibility of boards and commissions for health benefits.] Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by amending Section 16.700 to: (1) conform to prior amendments to the Charter and Administrative Code that made members of certain additional boards and commissions eligible for membership in the Health Service System, and (2) authorize the governing board of the Treasure Island Development Authority to enroll its employees in the Health Service System. Board amendment deletions are strikethrough normal. Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco: Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 16.700 to read as follows: SEC. 16.700, PARTICIPATION, The following shall be eligible to participate in the Health Service System: (a) City and County employees. (1) All permanent employees of the City and County of San Francisco whose normal work week at the time of inclusion is the system in not less than twenty (20) hours: (2) All regularly scheduled provisional employees of the City and County of San Francisco whose normal work week at the time of inclusion in the system is not less than twenty (20) hours; (3) All other employees of the City and County of San Francisco, including "as needed" employees, who have worked one thousand and forty hours (1040) in any consecutive twelve (12) month period and whose normal work week at the time of inclusion in the system is not less than twenty (20) hours.
