Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter dated August 21, 2003, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent with the General Plan and in conformance with the Eighth Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of such letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 041115

Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 174,891, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. <u>041115</u>, Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Section 1564. The width of sidewalks on the west side of Lyon Street at Chestnut Street shall be as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-562, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 041(15).
