RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds from CJP for the purposes of the Violence Against Women Vertical Prosecution Program; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for purposes of

9 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the  
10 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and be it


11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to  
12 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

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


