3 **Resolution Authorizing the Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco to**
4 **accept and expend grant funds made available through the U.S. Department of Justice**
5 **– Office of Community Oriented Policing for a project entitled “U.S. Department of**
6 **Justice – Universal Hiring Program.”**

8 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco desires to
9 undertake a certain project designated “U.S. Department of Justice – Universal Hiring
10 Program”, to be funded in part from funds made available through the U.S. Department of
11 Justice – Office of Community Oriented Policing (hereinafter referred to as DOJ/COPS); and,

12 WHEREAS, this grant will provide partial funding for the hiring of much needed
13 additional sworn officers; and,

14 WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget, and
15 require the city to assume any liability arising out of the performance of this grant agreement;
16 now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is
18 authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and
19 expend continued funding for this project from DOJ/COPS; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
21 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it


22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San

24 necessary Grant Agreement for this project including any extensions, funding augmentations

3 responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency; and be it


4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
