5 **years of providing an alternative approach to the crisis of homelessness in San**

8 WHEREAS, Community Housing Partnership was founded in 1990 by a group of  
9 homeless advocates, social service providers, and housing developers who came together to  
10 design an alternative approach to the crisis of homelessness in San Francisco; and

11 WHEREAS, Community Housing Partnership has integrated permanent, affordable  
12 housing with support services, training, and employment opportunities, offering tenants a  
13 range of resources to achieve stability and independence; and

14 WHEREAS, Community Housing Partnership owns and/or operates 310 units of  
15 permanent supportive housing, providing men, women and children with a home, including  
16 families, veterans, persons with HIV, individuals with substance abuse issues or mental health  
17 disabilities; and

18 WHEREAS; Community Housing Partnership holds the belief that formerly homeless  
19 people are uniquely qualified to serve in the organization, from the day-to-day operation of  
20 their buildings to policy-making on their governing board; and

21 WHEREAS; Community Housing Partnership is the lead agency of the Supportive  
22 Housing Employment Collaborative which offers workplace education, job training and  
23 employment services to formerly homeless tenants; and

1           WHEREAS; Community Housing Partnership offers tenants support services to  
2 address any issues they may face, and all services are optional, as Community Housing  
3 Partnership believes in respecting tenants' self-determination and free will; and

4           WHEREAS; Community Housing Partnership is committed to increasing the number of  
5 supportive housing units in San Francisco through advocacy, technical assistance, and  
6 housing development, therefore be it

7           RESOLVED; That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors honors and commends  
8 Community Housing Partnership for fifteen years of providing an environment that fosters  
9 independence to help break the cycle of homelessness.
