Resolution designating the USA PATRIOT Act as a "watch law" under Charter Section 16.124.

WHEREAS, Charter Section 16.124, adopted by the voters of San Francisco at the March 2, 2004 election, authorizes the Board of Supervisors, by resolution, to designate as a "watch law" any state or federal law or regulation that calls for, authorizes, or requires the production by any City officer, employee, agency, department, or office of information, records, or other tangible things held by the City, the disclosure of which could violate the rights of any individuals under the State or Federal Constitutions; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the further authority provided in Charter Section 16.124, the Board of Supervisors has adopted Administrative Code Section 2.20, which provides that the Board of Supervisors shall respond on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to all orders or requests for the production of information, records or other tangible things served on the City and County under any law designated as a watch law, and

WHEREAS, The "Uniting and Strengthening America by Providing Appropriate Tools Required to Intercept and Obstruct Terrorism (USA PATRIOT) Act of 2001" (PL 107-56) includes provisions that would allow the FBI to obtain personal records of San Francisco residents held by the City, such as library circulation records, without a warrant or an independent determination of probable cause by a neutral magistrate, potentially in violation of the Fourth Amendment rights and privacy rights of individuals named or discussed in such records; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors designates the USA PATRIOT Act to be a "watch law" under Charter Section 16.124; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to take appropriate steps to inform all City officers, departments, and agencies of this designation and of the procedures for handling watch law orders or requests.
