WHEREAS, Said Housing and Economic Development Policies expired in 2001; and. WHEREAS, This Board of Supervisors wishes to urge the Agency to establish a policy that sets a clear intent that the Agency will use over 50% of the total tax increment funds allocated each year from all the Agency's redevelopment project areas for the provision of low and moderate income housing and to include a statement of such policy intent in all future redevelopment plans submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval; now, therefore, be it ///

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby urges the Agency to establish a policy that sets a clear intent that the Agency will use over 50% of the total tax increment funds allocated each year from all the Agency's redevelopment project areas for the provision of low and moderate income housing; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby urges the Agency to include a statement of such policy intent in all future redevelopment plans submitted to the Board of Supervisors for its approval.
