WHEREAS, the ELJC requested assistance from the Environmental Justice program of the San Francisco Department of the Environment (SFE) to help plan, organize and conduct outreach for the CAA educational workshop and EJ conference; and,

WHEREAS, the ELJC will provide a grant award in the amount of \$23,000.00 to the Environmental Justice program of SFE as compensation for its staff time and effort, for conducting administrative and outreach services related to the CAA educational workshop and EJ conference; and,

WHEREAS, the CAA workshop and EJ conference are consistent and supportive of the SFE Environmental Justice program's strategic plan goals of providing educational services to
