- 1. The membership of the Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Force has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco;
- Applicant Scott Hoshida, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the Childhood Nutrition & Physical Activity Task Force;

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Scott Hoshida, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
