WHEREAS, Nationally, eighty three percent of foster children are held back by the third grade, nearly fifty percent suffer from chronic health conditions, and a history of foster care correlates with becoming homeless at an earlier age and remaining homeless for a longer period of time; and,

WHEREAS, In San Francisco, approximately 241 youth will "age out", or emancipate between November 2003 and October 2004; and,

WHEREAS, More dedicated foster parents are needed to provide family care for children who cannot live with their parents; and,

WHEREAS, Although there are numerous individuals and public, private and nonprofit organizations that work to empower and support foster youth, it is the responsibility of the entire community to ensure that each youth who leaves the foster care system in California has a permanent connection with a caring adult; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco is committed to youth engagement, empowerment, and leadership; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco recognizes the month of May 2004 as Foster Care Month.
