Resolution making environmental findings and approving a schedule of fees to be charged by the County Agriculture Commissioner for testing of weighing and measuring devices initiated by written request and for reinspecting, retesting and recertifying weighing and measuring devices found to be outside the tolerances of specifications set by the California Department of Food and Agriculture upon an initial inspection prescribed by California Business and Professions Code Section 12210(a).

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Resolution are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 040765 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has authorized the County Agriculture Commissioner under San Francisco Administrative Code Sections 1.15.1(b) and (c) to establish a schedule of fees for testing of weighing and measuring devices initiated by written request and for reinspecting, retesting and recertifying weighing and measuring devices found to be outside the tolerances or specifications set by the California Department of Food and Agriculture upon an initial inspection prescribed by California Business and Professions Code Section 12210(a); and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 12210.5 of the California Business and Professions Code and San Francisco Administrative Code Section 1.15.1(b), the fee schedule adopted by the County Agriculture Commissioner shall be in accordance with those fees established by the Secretary of Food and Agriculture of the State of California (hereafter referred to as "Director"); and,

WHEREAS. The fees established by the Director in DMS Notice D-03-9 are on file with 040765 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. , and are hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The following schedule of fees to be charged by the County Agriculture Commissioner are found to be in accordance with the fees established by the Director; and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 1.15.1(d), the fee schedule adopted by the County Agriculture Commissioner and any changes to the fee schedule must be ratified by resolution of the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the County Agriculture Commissioner may charge the following schedule of fees for testing of weighing and measuring devices initiated by written request and for reinspections, retesting and recertification of weighing and measuring devices that are found to be outside the tolerances or specifications set by the California Department of Food and Agriculture upon an initial inspection prescribed by California Business and Professions Code Section 12210(a):

All charges to be on a portal-to-portal basis plus mileage charge as indicated:

Small Capacity Scales:

\$85.00/hour + \$1.50/mile (up to 10,000 GVW)

Large Capacity Scales: (All scales over 3,000 lbs. capacity)

\$100.00/hour + \$2.00/mile (10,000 to 40,000 GVW) \$130.00/hour + \$2.50/mile (more than 40,000 GVW)

Retail Gasoline Dispensers:

\$70.00/hour + \$0.75/mile

Wholesale Petroleum Meters:

\$70.00/hour + \$1.00/mile

Liquefied Petroleum Gas Meters: \$70.00/hour + \$0.85/mile

All Other Commercial Devices:

\$70.00/hour + \$1.00/mile
