FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Rita Times, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a
 person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the Child Care
 Planning and Advisory Council.
- 3. The Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has attempted to fill the position, for which Rita Times was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who

has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Rita Times is qualified to serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council.

4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Rita Times, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
