[Supplemental grant award for comprehensive drug court implementation services.]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$53,742 from the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (CADP) to supplement comprehensive drug court implementation funding and to enter into an agreement for the use of these funds; for the period of December 29, 2003, to December 28, 2004.

WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from CADP in the amount of \$53,742 to provide supplemental comprehensive drug court implementation funding; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CADP requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 040171, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors because the notice of the supplemental award was not received from the State until after April 1, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$53,742 from CADP; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
