Historical & Cultural Society for their dedication and commitment to contributing to the development and growth of San Francisco's African American community.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco African American Historical & Cultural Society (the "Society") was founded in 1955 by James Herndon, Esq. and a group of young African American men and women who recognized the need for a forum where African Americans and others could come together to analyze, discuss devise strategies to address pertinent local, national and international issues; and,

WHEREAS, The Society is the lineal descendant of the Athenaeum Library Company, a literary society that was established by members of San Francisco's African American community in the 1850's; and,

WHEREAS, The Society's mission is to contribute to the growth and development of San Francisco's African American community by documenting and presenting true accounts of its history; promoting the study and appreciation of African American history and culture, particularly by African American youth; and by continuing to provide a discussion forum and African-American life and history; and,

WHEREAS, For the past 49years the Society has consistently presented exhibits and programs of the highest quality that accurately reflect the contributions of African Americans to the broader community; and,

WHEREAS, The Society's Library and Archives are an invaluable to educators, students, scholars, writers, film makers and the general public who seek accurate information

and historic documents and artifacts that tell the story of African Americans in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, In 1958 the Society merged with the local chapter of the Association for Study of African American Life and History, and thereby becoming the official sponsor of Black History Month in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, Since 1991 the Society has sponsored the official kickoff to Black History Month in the Rotunda of City Hall; and,

WHEREAS, Over the years the Society and its members have been at the forefront of efforts to improve the quality of life for all San Franciscans; and,

WHEREAS, The Society is a membership organization, with membership open to all who support the Society's mission; and,

WHEREAS, The Society collaborates with institutions from other communities to present programs and exhibits that highlight the contributions of each group and demonstrate the values of collaboration and cooperation; and,

WHEREAS, The Society is best position to help African American and other youth develop a deeper appreciation of who they are, where they come from and where their responsibility to the community; and,

WHEREAS, Throughout its history the Society has hosted leading African and African American dignitaries during visits to San Francisco; and, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisor recognized and commend the San Francisco African American Historical & Cultural Society for their dedication and commitment to contributing to the growth and development of San Francisco's African American community.
