

1 [APPOINTMENT OF POLICE DEPARTMENT EXECUTIVES]

2 AMENDING SAN FRANCISCO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE CHAPTER 2A, ARTICLE IV,
3 SECTION 2A.77 TO ALLOW THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPOINT EXEMPT NON-
4 CIVIL SERVICE EXECUTIVES FROM THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT AND ABOVE.

5 Note: Additions are underlined; deletions are
6 in ((double parentheses)).

7 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San
8 Francisco:

9 Section 1. Chapter 2A, Article IV of the San Francisco
10 Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 2A.77, to
11 read as follows:

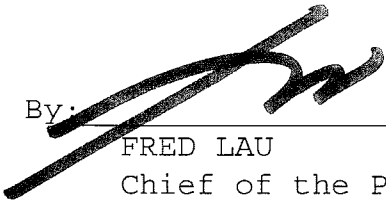
12 POLICE; OTHER EXECUTIVES. Subject to the provisions of the
13 Charter governing the appointment and removal of non-civil service
14 appointees, and without competitive examination, the Chief of Police
15 shall have the power to appoint a police surgeon; to appoint among
16 the members of the Department holding the civil service rank of
17 ((captain)) lieutenant or higher, a member to any non-civil service
18 rank above captain as may be created by the Police Commission
19 pursuant to the provisions of Section 2A.76 from among the members of
20 the Department holding the rank or ranks designated by said
21 commission pursuant to the provisions of Section 2A.76 of this Code.
22 However, to be eligible for appointment to any non-civil service rank
23 above Captain, a lieutenant must have passed the 6 month probationary
24 period and served an additional 6 months as a permanent employee in
25 that rank.

6 ((No appointment shall be made which would result in a member
7 holding a lower civil service rank or position supervising a member
8 holding a higher civil service rank or position.))

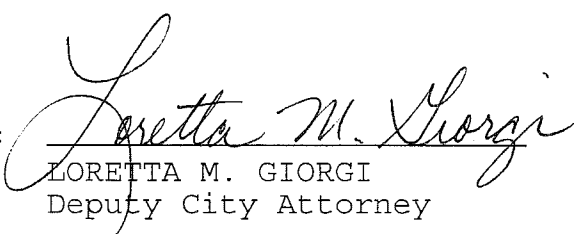

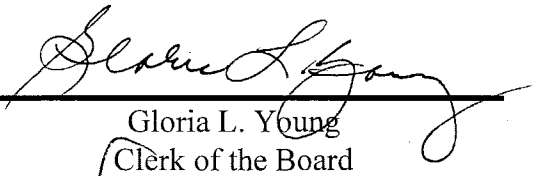
