WHEREAS, a quote for the 10 multimedia systems listing all of the separate components has been submitted and approved by POST and

WHEREAS, the terms of the legislation establishing the program do not allow indirect or administrative costs; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Sheriff's Department is hereby directed to purchase 10 multimedia systems and submit to the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training an attestation Supervisors Katz, Newsom
