10	residential density and pedestrian and bicyclist safety in conducting surveys; and,
11	WHEREAS, The California League of Cities has asked its members to support AB 2767; and,
12	WHEREAS, AB 2522 would enhance the penalties for persons found guilty of negligently colliding with a vehicle
13	or pedestrian in a marked or unmarked crosswalk, would require the Department of Motor Vehicles to revoke the license of
14	such an offender for a period of at least 3 months, and would increase the penalty for passing a vehicle stopped to allow a
15	pedestrian or bicyclist to cross; and,
16	WHEREAS, Senate bill 1809 would reapportion funds from the California Transportation Commission to provide
17	not less than 10 percent be programmed for transportation enhancement activities; now, therefore, be it
18	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby support AB 2767, SB 1809, and AB 2522,
19	State Legislative actions which would contribute to making San Francisco a more livable city with respect to transportation
20	options; and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby ask that copies of this resolution
21	be sent to our State representatives and to His Honor the Mayor, urging that all necessary steps be taken for passage of these
22	bills.
