[Assembly Bill 1731 - Nursing Home Care]

URGING THE STATE LEGISLATURE TO ADOPT ASSEMBLY BILL 1731, WHICH WOULD STRENGTHEN ENFORCEMENT AND OVERSIGHT OF NURSING HOMES TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF CARE.

WHEREAS, In July 1998, the U.S. General Accounting Office released a scathing report on skilled nursing care in California. The findings suggested that California's existing nursing facility regulatory and enforcement system does not effectively assess or ensure the quality of resident care; and,

WHEREAS, Current law requires applicants for nursing home licenses to maintain a cash reserve sufficient to operate the facility for up to 45 days causing for bankruptcies and disruptions in care; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1731, authored by State Assemblyman Kevin Shelley will enable citizens with long-term care needs to live at home, with family members, and in the community for as long as possible; and,

WHEREAS, The bill will increase access to quality alternatives to nursing home facilities by providing improved in-home support services and community-based care services; and,

WHEREAS, The bill also ensures that nursing home facilities in California provide safe and secure environments for residents and their families and that they have the highest quality of care possible; now, therefore, be it
