[Traffic Regulations]

ENACTING AND RESCINDING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ON VARIOUS STREETS.

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

DIAMOND LANE - ESTABLISH

Stockton Street, west curb lane (southbound), between O'Farrell and Ellis Streets

<u>RIGHT TURN ONLY - RESCIND</u> RIGHT TURN ONLY, EXCEPT BUSES AND TAXIS - ESTABLISH

Stockton Street, southbound, at Ellis Street (adds bus and taxi exemptions)

CROSSWALK CLOSURE - RESCIND

Stockton and Ellis Streets, north crosswalk, crossing Stockton Street (crosswalk to be restored)

TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME - RESCIND

Stillman Street, south side, between 3rd and 4th Streets

LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT - ESTABLISH

Fulton Street, eastbound, at Central Avenue


TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME - ESTABLISH

Front Street, east side, from Sacramento Street to 72 feet southerly (72-foot zone, along widened sidewalk)

Mission Street, west side, from Santa Rosa Avenue to 18 feet northerly (18-foot zone, along widened sidewalk)

San Juan Avenue, south side, from Mission Street to 18 feet westerly (18-foot zone, along corner bulb)
