URGING THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE SAN FRANCISCO POLICE COMMISSION TO PROVIDE A COMPLETE REPORT TO THE FULLEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW TO THE PUBLIC REGARDING OFFICE OF CITIZENS COMPLAINT FILE #0861-96 (GARCIA FAMILY OCC COMPLAINT)

WHEREAS, In April of 1996, an incident transpired between Mark Garcia and Officers of the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) which resulted in the death of Mark Garcia; and

WHEREAS, The Garcia Family filed a complaint was filed with the Office of Citizen's Complaints (OCC) in October 1996; and

WHEREAS, After an investigation was conducted, the OCC and brought its sustained findings to the department as a whole (OCC File #0861-96); and

WHEREAS, The OCC then presented a verified complaint to the San Francisco Police Commission and the San Francisco Police Department, pursuant to Police Commission Resolution number 19-91, and

WHEREAS, Resolution 19-91 set forth the general protocol when the Director of the OCC and the Chief of Police disagree on whether disciplinary action is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Not until file #861-96 was presented to the Chief of Police and the Police Commission did it become clear that Resolution 19-91 was ambiguous in prescribing specific solutions when disagreements did arise between the OCC and the SFPD ;and

WHEREAS, After the Chief of Police has held a hearing in the matter of OCC Complaint 0816-96 (Garcia Family OCC Complaint), an agreement was reached between the SFPD and OCC that the findings and dispositions resulting from that evidentiary hearing were to be reported to the public to the fullest extent allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, The Chief of Police and the Police Commission have not yet provided these required reports to the public; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges both the Chief of Police and the San Francisco Police Commission to provide a complete report to fullest extent allowed by law to the public regarding OCC file #0861-96 (Garcia Family OCC Complaint).
