WHEREAS, The method by which the school district communicates its plans to impacted communities should be consistent and uniform; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the San Francisco Unified School District to develop a Community Notification Policy to inform surrounding residents and property owners when the school district is proposing a new or relocated school, school-run program, or other development.
