INTERDEPARTMENAL WORKING GROUP FOCUSED ON PEDESTRIAN SAFETY TO ADVISE

THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGARDING PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

ISSUES.

WHEREAS, To date, eighteen pedestrians have died on the streets of San Francisco this year and hundreds have been injured; and,

WHEREAS, The rates of both fatal and non-fatal pedestrian injury in San Francisco are nearly double that of the nation, state, and other major urban areas within the state; and,

WHEREAS, Pedestrian fatalities account for only 13% of all traffic fatalities nationally, but account for almost 50% of traffic fatalities in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, Pedestrian injuries account for only 2% of injuries nationally, but in San Francisco, pedestrians account for more than a third of hospitalizations; and,

WHEREAS, Several City departments have responsibility for various aspects of pedestrian safety education, enforcement, engineering, and planning; and,

WHEREAS, Some of those departments participate in a Pedestrian Safety Task Force, yet not all departments are included in that task force; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby directs the Department of Parking and Traffic

safety; and be it further,

RESOLVED, That this working group shall include the Department of Parking and Traffic, the Department of Public Health, the Police Department, the Department of Public Works, the Department of Planning, the Redevelopment Agency, the Transportation Authority, the San Francisco Unified School District, the Municipal Railway, the District Attorney's Office, the San Francisco Convention and Visitors Bureau, the Mayor's Office on Disability, and the Commission on Aging; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the interdepartmental working group shall advise the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors on pedestrian safety issues and shall provide quarterly reports to the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors.
