COMMENDING LATINOS EN EXTASIS FOR THEIR WORK IN EDUCATING YOUTH
ABOUT SEXUAL HEALTH AND FOR REPRESENTING SAN FRANCISCO YOUTH AT THE
2000 INTERNATIONAL AIDS CONFERENCE IN DURBAN, SOUTH AFRICA.

WHEREAS, Since 1997, Mission Neighborhood Health Center (MNHC) has hosted Latinos en Extasis (which translates to Latinos living life to the fullest), a culturally sensitive peer based youth HIV, STD, and pregnancy prevention program for Latino youth ages 13 to 18; and,

WHEREAS, Latinos en Extasis supports the concept that youth are more likely to adapt a new behavior or idea if it comes from their peers; and,

WHEREAS, Drawing on the proven effectiveness that comes from peer leadership, Latinos en Extasis has identified and recruited female and male teen leaders who have been trained to become Peer Outreach Educators (POEs); and,

WHEREAS, In the two a half years since it began, Latinos en Extasis has trained 37 young Health Educators, educated over 300 peer-led group participants, and reached over 1,500 teens in the greater Mission District in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, Seven young Peer Educators age 15-18 will participate in the 2000 International AIDS Conference in July in Durban, South Africa; and,

WHEREAS, Since 1985, The International AIDS Conference has provided a forum for academic, industrial, and social activists to share ideas and focus on the prevention and treatment of HIV and AIDS; and,

WHEREAS, The youth will go to the conference not as observers but as active participants representing their community and learning from others involved in preventing the spread of HIV; and,

WHEREAS, The Peer Educators have submitted an abstract to the conference titled "Voices to Live By" and they have been invited to participate with the "Names Project - World Aids Quilt" at the display in Durban; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends *Latinos in Extasis* for their work in educating youth about sexual health and for representing San Francisco youth at the 2000 International Aids Conference in Durban, South Africa.
