RESOLVED, That pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 14000 et seq., the BART election to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on November 7, 2000 shall be and hereby is consolidated with the General Municipal Election scheduled for the same date; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the voting precincts, polling places, and officers for the election shall, in every case, be the same; that there shall be only one set of election officers in each precinct, to wit: the election officers to be appointed by the Director of Elections for each precinct; that the candidates and measures, and bond proposals, and candidates for the Board of Directors of BART shall be set forth on the ballots provided for said election; that the election shall be held in all respects as though there were only one election, and that all
