

1 CONCURRING WITH THE CONTROLLER'S CERTIFICATION THAT LEGAL PROCESS  
2 SERVER SERVICES CAN BE PRACTICALLY PERFORMED FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY,  
3 FAMILY SUPPORT BUREAU, BY A PRIVATE CONTRACTOR FOR A LOWER COST THAN  
4 SIMILAR SERVICES PERFORMED BY CITY AND COUNTY EMPLOYEES.

6 WHEREAS, the electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition J in  
7 November, 1976, (now Section 10.104.15 of the Charter) allowing City Departments to contract with  
8 private companies for specific services which can be practically performed for a lower cost than similar  
9 work by City and County employees; and,

10 WHEREAS, the District Attorney, Family Support Bureau, has sought and received estimates  
11 from a private contractor and wishes to contract for legal process server services; and,


12 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified on April 18, 2000, that said services can be performed at  
13 a lower cost to the City and County by private contractor than by employees of the City and County;




