WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition "J" in November 1976 adding Section 10.104.15 to the Charter allowing City Departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can practically be performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and County employees; and,

WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on June 23, 2000 that services involved in the management and operation of Information Booths at San Francisco International Airport for fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2000 can be performed by private contractor at a lower cost to the City and County of San Francisco than if such services were performed by employees of the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104.15 of the Charter, this Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively approves said Controller's certification.
