URGING ALL SAN FRANCISCO CITY DEPARTMENTS AND COMMISSIONS TO HELP STATE-FUNDED NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE SERVICES TO PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES REGISTER THEIR CLIENTS TO VOTE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NATIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION ACT OF 1993.

WHEREAS, The National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (NVRA) was passed with the intent of increasing the number of registered voters in Federal elections throughout the United States; and,

WHEREAS, The NVRA requires states to designate state-funded organizations that are primarily engaged in providing services to persons with disabilities as voter registration agencies; and,

WHEREAS, Examples of such agencies include, but are not limited to, organizations involved in vocational rehabilitation and special education, commissions for the deaf and the blind, para-transit providers, independent living centers, and disability-specific service providers; and,

WHEREAS, The services to be provided by these agencies include voter registration of their clients during the application, intake, re-certification, change-of-address and/or orientation process; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco contracts with a large number of such organizations that are not currently providing these required services;

WHEREAS, Such services would empower an often neglected group of voters, increase the representation of persons with disabilities in the electorate and reinforce their role in the democratic process; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby

urges all San Francisco City Departments and Commissions to help state-funded non-profit organizations that provide services to people with disabilities register their clients to vote in accordance with the National Voter Registration Act of 1993.
