AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$546,940 OF TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) ARTICLE 3 FUNDS FOR BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN PROJECTS FOR FY 2000-01.

WHEREAS, Article 3 of the Transportation Development Act (TDA), as amended (Pub. Util. Code Secs. 99233.3 and 99234), provides for the disbursement of funds in the nine-county Metropolitan Transportation Commission region for bicycle and pedestrian purposes;

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has identified \$273,470 of work to improve access for persons with disabilities by construction or reconstruction of curb ramps at various locations in the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic has identified \$273,470 of work for various bicycle projects and programs; and,

WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible according to State of California rules and regulations; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to TDA Article 3, as amended, and pursuant to the applicable rules and regulations thereunder (21 CA Admin Code 6600 et.seq.), a prospective claimant wishing to receive an allocation must file its claim with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works will require \$273,740 to construct new curb ramps and to reconstruct certain curb ramps to

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make them fully compliant with the federal American with Disabilities Act; and,

WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission adopted Resolution No. 110-00-PTC at its March 21, 2000 meeting authorizing the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to execute documents necessary to apply for, accept, and expend up to \$327,439 of FY 2000-01 TDA Article 3 funds for various bicycle projects and programs; and,

WHEREAS, DPT has adjusted its project budget to reflect the reduced amount of funding available; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of Public Works to accept and expend \$546,940 in Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 Funds for bicycle and pedestrian projects for FY 2000-01 and to execute any and all documents necessary therefore.
