WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1760, Chapter 133, Statutes of 1996 establishes the Juvenile Crime Enforcement and Accountability Challenge Grant (JCE&ACG) Program under the authority of the State Board of Corrections; and,

WHEREAS, On May 15, 1997 the State Board of Corrections awarded the City and County of San Francisco \$5,407,983 under the JCEACG program to implement a local action plan to provide a continuum of responses to juvenile crime and delinquency; and,

WHEREAS, On November 21, 1997 the San Francisco Board of Supervisors approved the acceptance and expenditure of \$5,407,983 in State Board of Corrections (BOC) funds, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 68-97-7; and,

WHEREAS, On February 7, 2000 the BOC amended the contract (# 028-97) between the City and County of San Francisco and the BOC to extend the project period,

SUPERVISORS BROWN, TENG, BECERRIL, NEWSAM

for a period of one year, until June 30, 2001, authorized by the State of California FY 1999-2000 Budget Act; and,

WHEREAS, The State of California FY 2000-2001 Budget Act, AB 1740, authorizes an additional \$595,000 for continuation funding for San Francisco's JCE&ACG program; and,

WHEAREAS, the entire award by the State Board of Corrections funds direct services and evaluation of those services during the fourth year of the JCE&ACG program, it is requested that indirect costs be waived, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the retroactively
Mayor's Criminal Justice Council to/accept and expend \$595,000 from the State Board of Corrections under the JCE&ACG program for the fourth year implementation of a juvenile justice local action plan to provide a continuum of responses to juvenile crime and delinquency.
