RESOLVED, That, pursuant to the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, the following intersections are hereby designated as "Stop" intersections, and the Department of Parking and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to cause "Stop" signs to be installed thereat as designated below:

- Broderick and Beach Streets, northwest and southeast corners, stopping Broderick Street (makes this an all-way STOP)
- London Street and France Avenue, northwest and southeast corners, stopping London Street (makes this an all-way STOP)
- Madrid and Rolph Streets, all corners, stopping all approaches (makes this uncontrolled T-intersection an all-way STOP)
- Paris and Rolph Streets, all corners, stopping all approaches (makes this uncontrolled T-intersection an all-way STOP)
- Marina Boulevard and Baker Street, northeast and southwest corners; stopping Marina Boulevard (makes this an all-way STOP)
- Marina Boulevard and Broderick Street, northeast and southwest comers, stopping Marina Boulevard (makes this an all-way STOP)
- Marina Boulevard and Divisadero Street, northeast and southwest corners, stopping Marina Boulevard (makes this an all-way STOP)
- Marina Boulevard and Webster Street, northeast and southwest corners, stopping Marina Boulevard (makes this an all-way STOP)
- Marina Boulevard, Avila Street, and Casa Way, northeast and southwest corners, stopping Marina Boulevard (makes this an all-way STOP)
