Section 1. This amount shall be distributed to workers of the former King Tin Restaurant whom the City's Office of Labor Standards Enforcement determines to have valid claims for violations of the City's Minimum Wage Ordinance.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on August 3, 2005, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: City and County of San Francisco, Plaintiff, and Kam Kong Tang and Kai Yuen Ng, Defendants.
