PROCEEDINGS UNTIL THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY HAS THE OPPORTUNITY TO

EXPRESS ITS VIEWS ON THE PROJECT THROUGH A PUBLIC HEARING, AND TO TAKE

INTO CONSIDERATION THOSE VIEWS IN IMPLEMENTING THE PLANS.

WHEREAS, A 1996 joint statement was issued by the Ft. Miley Homeowners and Residents Association, the Lincoln Park Neighborhood Association, the Planning Association for the Richmond, the People for a Golden Gate National Recreation Area and the Veterans Affairs Medical Center, which recognized an interest in preserving the visual integrity of the Medical Center in a manner consistent with the adjacent neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, The public viewing session of the current landscaping plans was scheduled for a time and day that did not provide the public an adequate opportunity for comment; and

WHEREAS, The landscaping plans displayed at this session contained insufficient detail; and

WHEREAS, The area of concern has served as a sound and visual buffer between the VAMC campus and the surrounding community; and

WHEREAS, The community has concerns about the impact of the landscaping and construction plans, in terms of their visual impact and size, reverberation of sound, and potential utilization of the area by community members; and

WHEREAS, The construction was set to begin at an unidentified point in September; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the San Francisco Veterans Affairs Medical Center to refrain from any

landscaping or construction proceedings until the surrounding community has the opportunity to express its views on the project through a public hearing; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Veterans Affairs Medical Center take into consideration the views of the community in implementing its plans for landscaping and construction.
