WHEREAS, the San Francisco Police Department's practice of community policing is predicated on having more police officers assigned to neighborhood District Stations; and,

WHEREAS, Even after the hiring of new police officers, many of the San Francisco District Police Stations continue to be understaffed; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Police Department to place a priority on District Stations when assigning newly hired police officers.
