WHEREAS, In 1993, AB 675 clarified that "harassment because of sex" under the Fair Employment and Housing Act includes, but is not limited to, sexual harassment, gender harassment, and harassment on the basis of pregnancy, however, until the last legislative session, there was no definition contained in the codes for "gender"; and,

WHEREAS, With passage of AB 1999 (Kuehl), Ch. 933, Statutes of 1999, a definition of gender now exists in the Penal Code; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Legislature is currently considering Assembly Bill 2142, the Gender Nondiscrimination Bill; and,

WHEREAS, The Gender Nondiscrimination Bill would clarify that for purposes of the Fair Employment and Housing Act discrimination on the basis of "sex" includes gender discrimination; and,

WHEREAS, AB2142 would reference the existing Penal Code definition for purposes of clarifying the entire Fair Employment and Housing Act; and,
