[Cellular Antenna Community Meeting Notification]

URGING THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR CELL SITE

COMMUNITY MEETING NOTIFICATION IN APPROPRIATE LANGUAGES.

WHEREAS, The Planning Code requires conditional use authorization to place major cellular antenna sites in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, In addition to Planning Code regulations, cellular antenna placement in San Francisco is governed by The City's Wireless Telecommunications Services Facilities Siting Guidelines adopted August 15, 1996; and

WHEREAS, These guidelines classify structures with a residential component as less desirable for placement of cellular antennas; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department recommends that project sponsors hold community meetings when placing an antenna at a site classified as less desirable; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of such meetings is to give residents a meaningful opportunity to express their sentiments about the location of such a project in their neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, In some instances, a great deal of residents do not comprehend the English-only notices currently posted for these community meetings; and

WHEREAS, These residents do not have the opportunity to participate in the community planning process; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Planning Department to establish procedures for cell site community meeting notification in appropriate languages; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that the Planning Department report back to the Board of Supervisors in three months.
