RESOLUTION NO. 840-00

[Traffic Regulations]

ENACTING AND RESCINDING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ON VARIOUS STREETS.

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

YIELD SIGNS - ESTABLISH

Faxon Avenue, southbound, at Northwood Drive

Plymouth Avenue, southbound, at Northwood Drive

NO LEFT TURNS - ESTABLISH

Persia Avenue, westbound, at Sunnydale Avenue

San Bruno Avenue, both directions, between Silliman and Felton Streets (prohibits mid-block left turns)

~~NO STOPPING OR WAITING IN PARKING AISLE - ESTABLISH~~

~~18th Avenue, off-street parking lot, between Geary Boulevard and Anza Street~~

~~8th Avenue and Irving Street, off-street parking lot~~

TOW-AWAY LANE MUST TURN RIGHT - ESTABLISH

6th Street, northbound, at Folsom Street

TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME - ESTABLISH

Potrero Avenue, east side, between Division and Alameda Streets

Potrero Avenue, east side, between Division and Alameda Streets




