ORDERING THE SUMMARY STREET VACATION OF A PORTION OF THE WESTERN END OF DOW PLACE; ADOPTING FINDINGS PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, CHAPTER 4, SECTIONS 8330 ET SEQ. (PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENT LAW, SUMMARY VACATION); AND ADOPTING FINDINGS OF CONFORMITY WITH THE GENERAL PLAN AND PRIORITY POLICIES OF PLANNING CODE SECTION 101.1.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

FINDINGS. The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby finds and declares as follows:

- A. The Public Works and Real Estate Departments have requested that the Board of Supervisors vacate and sell a portion of Dow Place.
- B. The proposed summary street vacation is necessary for fire truck turnaround radius requirements in connection with residential project being developed by the adjacent property owner, 77 Dow Place Lofts, LLC.
- C. The subject portion of the street is described and depicted on the Department of Public Works Drawing number SUR-498, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.  $\_$   $^{991757}$
- D. Section 8334 of Chapter 4 of Part 3 of the California Streets and Highways Code provides that the legislative body of a local agency may summarily vacate a street if such street is an excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes.
- E. The portion of Dow Place described in Department of Public Works drawing SUR-498 is an excess right of way that is no longer required for street or highway

purposes pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 8334. Such portion of Dow Place is necessary to provide for fire truck turning radius in connection with a residential development adjacent to the site. In addition, the Board finds that no in-place utility facilities exist in the portions of the street that will be effected by the summary vacation.

F. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference as though fully set forth herein the findings of the City Planning Department in its letter dated June 19, 1998 that found the proposed vacation and sale of the subject portion of Dow Place is in conformity with the City's General Plan and with the Eight Priority Policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of such letter is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.

Section 2. Pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3. Chapter 4 Sections 8330 et seq. (Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Law, Summary Vacation), the Board of Supervisors hereby orders the summary vacation of a portion of Dow Place as described in the aforementioned drawing and such portion of the street will no longer constitute a street or highway.

Section 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby directs its Clerk to transmit to the Recorder, the Director of Public Works, and the Director of Property, a certified copy of this Ordinance, and such official are hereby directed to proceed thereafter as required by law.
