[Sprint Spectrum Limited Partnership Company Transmitter Lease]

Resolution authorizing and approving a lease of cellular transmitter space at the Performing Arts Garage to Sprint Spectrum Limited Partnership.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the following findings regarding a proposed lease of cellular transmitter space within the Performing Arts Garage at Grove and Gough Streets, Block 792 Lot 29 (the "Garage"), owned by the San Francisco Parking Authority (the "Authority"); the Director of Property has negotiated a form of agreement (the "Lease") with Sprint Spectrum Limited Partnership (SSLP) for the lease of the Premises for a monthly rental of \$3,000.00 for a term of five years, with the Authority having the right to extend the lease for a period of five years; and there is an annual rent increase based upon the Consumer Price Index and the rent will be reappraised prior to the exercise of the option; and the Lease also provides that the cost of all tenant improvements to the Premises will be borne by SSLP; and SSLP will pay all electric utility costs; and

WHEREAS, SSLP has received a City Planning Commission approval and the Authority approval by Resolution No. 113-00-PA, as well as a building permit to place seven equipment cabinets and nine antennae at the Performing Arts Garage; and

WHEREAS, a form of the Lease is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with the recommendation of the Director of the Parking Authority and the Director of Property, the Mayor, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Director of Property are hereby authorized to take all actions, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, as Landlord, to execute a written lease and other related documents with SSLP, as Tenant; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the Authority to enter into the Lease based upon direct negotiations with SSLP without a competitive bid process. Competitive bidding in this situation would be impracticable or impossible. There is sufficient space for a second cell phone company to place a transmitter and antenna on this site; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute, and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to attest and affix the seal of the City thereon, the Lease on behalf of the Parking Authority of San Francisco on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the lease shall be subject to and conditioned upon, the Human Rights Commission's approval of SSLP's compliance with City's Non-Discrimination and Equal Benefits in Employment Ordinance; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Property to enter into any amendments or modifications to the Lease (including without limitation, the exhibits) that the Director of Property determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interest of the City, do not increase the rent or otherwise materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate

1	the purposes of the Lease or this resolution, and are in compliance with all applicable laws
