[Suspension of Muni Fares]

ACTIONS PREVIOUSLY TAKEN

P.M. ON DECEMBER 31, 1998 TO 3 A.M. ON JANUARY 1, 1999 AND RATIFYING

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

APPROVING THE SUSPENSION OF FARES ON MUNI REVENUE VEHICLES FROM 8

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby finds and declares the following:

- A. The suspension of fares on revenue vehicles operated by the Public Transportation Department ("MUNI") on the eve and morning of January 1, 1999 will increase public safety and improve traffic conditions in the City and County of San Francisco (the "City").
- B. The City intends to accept a gift or gifts to the City to offset the cost of suspending MUNI fares on the eve and morning of January 1, 1999.
- C. Section 15273 of State CEQA Guidelines (rates, tolls, fares, and charges) exempts this project from environmental review. The project, including the acceptance of any gift referred to in paragraph B above, will meet operating expenses consistent with the existing fare structure.
- Section 2. The City and County of San Francisco shall not charge passengers fares on revenue vehicles operated by the Public Transportation Department during the period beginning at 8 p.m. on December 31, 1998 and ending at 3 a.m. on January 1, 1999. Fares in effect before 8 p.m. on December 31, 1998 shall resume after 3 a.m. on January 1, 1999.
- Section 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies any New Year's Eve fare suspension consistent with the terms of this ordinance implemented by the Public Transportation Commission after the passage of this ordinance but prior to the ordinance's actual effective date.
