[Competitive Bidding And Prevailing Wage Exemption] WAIVING COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS AND PREVAILING WAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RECREATION AND PARK COMMISSION'S AWARD OF CONTRACT TO THE SAN FRANCISCO CONSERVATION CORPS FOR RENOVATION OF PLAY AREA AT ROLPH PLAYGROUND AT POTRERO AVENUE AND CESAR CHAVEZ STREET

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. FINDINGS SUPPORTING WAIVER OF COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS AND PREVAILING WAGE REQUIREMENTS IN AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR RENOVATION OF PLAY AREA AT ROLPH PLAGROUND AT POTRERO AVENUE AND CESAR CHAVEZ STREET.

The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco makes the following findings:

- 1. The San Francisco Conservation Corps is a non-profit organization that serves the public interest by providing job training and work experience for disadvantaged individuals in need of such training and work experience and has a Board of Directors appointed by the Mayor.
- 2. Policies and programs that enhance the skills of disadvantaged individuals will best serve the public interest because the development of such individuals will have a significant positive impact on the economic health of the City.
- 3. The Recreation and Park Department wishes to award one contract for the renovation of the play area at Rolph Playground to the San Francisco Conservation Corps without a competitive bid even though the expenditure involved in such contract exceeds \$50,000.

- 4. Waiver of competitive bid requirements in the award of the contract for renovation of the play area at Rolph Playground would serve the public interest of providing training and work experience for disadvantaged individuals.
- 5. Without a waiver of competitive bid requirements, the San Francisco Conservation Corps would be unable to compete for and win award of the contract.

Section 2. **EXEMPTION.** The contract for the renovation of the play area at Rolph Playground shall be exempt from the competitive bidding requirements of Chapter 6 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, and may be awarded to the San Francisco Conservation Corps.

Section 3. **EXEMPTION.** Under Charter Section A7.204(b), for purposes of the contract for the renovation of the play area at Rolf Playground, the San Francisco Conservation Corps shall be exempt from the Charter's prevailing wage requirements.
