Section 2. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding Section 174.08 thereto, which reads as follows:

SEC. 174.08. A prima facie speed limit of 25 miles per hour is hereby established on Guerrero Street, from Market Street to San Jose Avenue.
