Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend \$25 million of State Transit Assistance funding for construction and construction support of Muni's Third Street Initial Operating Segment and Metro East facility.

WHEREAS, The State Controller has allocated transportation funds to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) to be subsequently allocated to eligible claimants in the MTC region; and

WHEREAS, These State accounts consist of Proposition 42 (Transportation Congestion Improvement Act) funds and Spillover Account funds composed of excess sales taxes from gasoline sales; and

WHEREAS, MTC has used this funding to create a State Transit Assistance (STA) fund to be allocated to eligible claimants in the MTC region; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

WHEREAS, STA funds can be used for any eligible operating expense or project purpose, including construction and construction support of Muni's Third Street Initial Operating Segment (IOS) and Metro East facility; and

WHEREAS, STA funding is a resource that may be used for construction and construction support of Muni's Third Street IOS and Metro East facility; and

WHEREAS, There is no allowance for citywide indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, MTA has submitted an application to MTC for \$25 million of FY 2007 STA funds: and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director/CEO of the MTA (or his designee) must execute agreements to complete transfer of the funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the MTA is authorized to accept and expend \$25 million in STA funds from the MTC for construction and construction support of Muni's IOS and Metro East facility; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional information or assurances may be requested by the funding agencies in connection with this request; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any and all agreements necessary to complete transfer of the funds.
