RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Sweatfree Procurement Advisory Group, pursuant to the provisions of Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 223-05, for the term specified:

Sarah Leiber Church (residency requirement waived), succeeding Abigail Levine, resigned, seat 3, must have significant experience as an advocate for human rights or the poor, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 17, 2007.

Virginia Villegas, succeeding Dale Jiajun Wen, resigned, seat 5, must be a member of the public, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 17, 2007; and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Sweatfree Procurement Advisory Group has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Sarah Leiber Church, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Sweatfree Procurement Advisory Group.
- 3. The Sweatfree Procurement Advisory Group has attempted to fill the position, for which Sarah Leiber Church was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Sarah Leiber Church, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
