WHEREAS, Aquatic Park Beach in San Francisco is a popular recreation and swimming area; and,

WHEREAS, Port staff and the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission have recorded elevated bacteria counts at Aquatic Park during the herring commercial fishing season; and,

WHEREAS, Port staff believe fish processing activities at Pier 45 are a contributing factor to observed bacteria counts and have developed a utility improvement project with the goal of reducing those counts; and,

WHEREAS, On November 15, 2006, through Board Resolution No. 2006-0082, the State Water Resources Control Board approved a grant of \$1.8 million to the Port of San Francisco to fund this project; and,

WHEREAS, On November 14, 2006, through Commission Resolution No. 06-78, the Port Commission authorized the Executive Director of the Port to enter into an agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board to accept and expend these grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, The Port Commission proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Port

Commission to accept and expend \$1.8 million in Proposition 40, Clean Beaches Initiative

grant funds from the State Water Resources Control Board for utility improvements at the Pier

45 fish processing facility; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the Port to execute any documents required for the implementation of this grant, including any amendments, augmentations or extensions thereof; and be it
