

[Accept-expend State Grant Funds available under the California Cultural and Historical Endowment to fund the South Murphy Windmill Restoration Project]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Recreation and Parks Department to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$488,411 for the restoration of the South Murphy Windmill, under Proposition 40 California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 administered by the California State Library, California Cultural and Historical Endowment.

WHEREAS, The California Cultural and Historical Endowment has received an appropriation from Propositions 40 California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002, which provides funds to the State of California for grants to eligible Applicants; and

WHEREAS, The California Cultural and Historical Endowment may distribute funds from Proposition 40 to Projects that provide a thread of California's cultural and historical resources; and,

WHEREAS, The South Murphy Windmill Renovation Project meets the objectives of the CCHE program; and,

WHEREAS, The California Cultural and Historical Endowment has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of and the grant Project shown above within the State, setting up necessary procedures; and,

WHEREAS, The Applicant will enter into a contract with the State of California for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; and, WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment;

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby approves the acceptance and expenditure of local assistance in the amount of \$488,411 for South Murphy Renovation Project from the California Cultural and Historical Endowment Program under the Proposition 40 California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco certifies that Grantee has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco certifies that Grantee has reviewed, understands and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the Contract shown in the Procedural Guide; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco appoints the Project Manager of the Recreation & Parks Department as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
