FURTHER RESOLVED, That The City and County of San Francisco appoints the General Manager of the Recreation & Park Department as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
