(6) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited. (7) Petitioner shall not permit its patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the sidewalks adjacent to the licensed premises. The orderly standing of patrons in line to enter the premises shall not be considered loitering or unlawfully congregating. (8) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (9) At any time the premises are providing live entertainment, the petitioner(s) shall provide security personnel that shall maintain order therein and prevent any activity which would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of their property by nearby residents. Said personnel shall be clothed in such a manner as to be readily identifiable as security. (10) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Department.
